FACILITY HIRING POLICY



Facility description:

- Large heated / air-conditioned function room (with seating for 120 people)
- Fully equipped kitchen and servery
- Bar facility (to be run by BBC staff when service of alcohol is required)
- Sound system including microphone and music capability
- Large TV with media presentation capability
- Male, female and disabled toilets
- Parking area with direct access to function room (including disabled access)

Hiring applications:

- All facility hiring applications must be made via the club's web site <http://buninyongbowlingclub.com.au/> or directly to the club's facility Booking Officer
- All applications are subject to Board approval.
- The facility **will not** be hired for 18th and 21st birthday functions.

Availability:

Monday afternoons Tuesday evenings (April – September) Wednesdays 1.00pm onwards Thursday evenings	Not available
Any other time (day or evening)	Available

Bar Facility Policy:

- All functions requiring alcohol must use the club licence / bar. No BYO alcohol is permitted.
- Bar staff will be provided.
- Under Liquor licencing provisions, no alcohol can be served after 11.30pm. Patrons are required to vacate the premises by 12.00am.
- No extension to the licence will be available.

Maximum booking numbers: 120

General:

- The club reserves the right to make decisions regarding hiring of the facility based on availability and function suitability
- It is expected that the facility will be cleaned by the hirer and left in the state that it was presented
- The club reserves the right to retain part or all of any bond monies to cover cleaning costs if required

- Patrons are not permitted access to any part of the bowling greens area – any damage to playing surfaces may result in loss of bond and/or additional charges
- No sticky tape, pins or other adhesives may be used on any surfaces throughout the facility
- The relevant BBC staff will advise patrons as to what form of decorations will be permitted for functions

Community groups / Charity organisations (No Bar)	Donation by negotiation
Commercial / Business groups	(Half day) \$150 (Full day) \$250
Private function with bar	\$250
Bond (returnable – subject to the conditions listed above (under General) <i>Note: Bond is to be paid 7 days prior to function</i>	
Function with Bar	\$200
Meeting / Function without Bar	\$100
