Regulations

1. CLUB UNIFORM & COLOURS

- 1.1 The club colours are bottle green and gold.
- 1.2 The club uniform will be worn by all members competing in pennant competition and club championship finals. Uniform as approved by Bowls Australia consists of:
 - I. The club-approved uniform bowling shirt
 - II. The club logo on the shirt pocket
 - III. Bottle green trousers, track pants, shorts or skirt
- 1.3 No advertising material or logos are to be displayed on any part of club uniform unless approved by the Board.

2. SELECTION COMMITTEE & CLUB COMPETITIONS

2.1 Selection and Match Committee

- (a) Saturday and Monday sections will each have a **Selection Committee** consisting of a minimum of three **(3)** and a maximum of five **(5)** members.
- (b) A **Match Committee** will consist of five **(5)** members, with a minimum of two **(2)** female and two **(2)** male members, with one of the members being appointed as the Tournament Director.
- (c) Selectors and Match Committee Members are elected at the Annual General Meeting.
- (d) In the absence of sufficient nominations the Board may appoint Selectors or Match Committee members. Under this condition, the Board may re-appoint a selector to serve longer than three years. However, that selector must again step down the following year.
- (e) Where possible, each division will have a representative on the Selection Committee.
- (f) Selectors are eligible to serve three consecutive years.

- (g) The Selection Committee may, at its discretion, elect a Chairperson of Selectors from their number.
- (h) The functions of the Selection Committee are to:
 - (i) Select pennant teams
 - (ii) Organise and manage pre-season practice games
- (i) The functions of the Match Committee are to organise and conduct:
 - I. Club championship events
 - II. Tournament events
- (j) The President of the club, if required, may act as an ex-officio selector in the absence of one of the selection committee.

2.2 Club Competitions and Trophies

- (a) The club will conduct the following annual championship events:

Men's Championships

- I. Singles Championship,
- II. Pairs Championship

Ladies' Championships

- I. Singles Championship
- II. Pairs Championship

Other Club events for Men and Ladies will be determined by the Match Committee.

- (b) The match committee will determine playing times and conditions for each competition.
- (c) A trophy will be provided for winners and runners up in each championship event.
- (d) The entrance fee for club competitions will be determined by the Board.
- (e) When entries for club championships have closed on the nominated date, the match committee will:
 - I. meet and create the draw for each championship competition
 - II. fix the appointed date for completion of each round
 - III. place the draw sheets on the club notice board.
- (f) A competitor in any club competition who fails to play in their draw on or before the appointed date, without a sufficient reason as accepted by the Match Committee, will forfeit the match and be ineligible to play further in that competition.

- (g)** All club competitions will be, as far as possible, played in accordance with the existing rules of Bowls Australia.
- (h)** Any protest or dispute regarding any club competition must be submitted in writing to the Match Committee for adjudication.
- (i)** Where the match committee cannot satisfactorily resolve any dispute regarding a club championship, the matter may be referred to the Board (or delegated Board member/s) for mediation or resolution.
